What is the First Article of the Creed?

Remember when you were given your first bicycle? Or maybe it was a car or a set of tools. You were given the gift, but they also came with instructions about how to care for them. We understand that the need for maintenance doesn't negate a gift. We understand that effort is required in order to maintain function and beauty in life. Bike tires need air, tools need cleaned, cars need oil changes. Lawns need mowed, houses need repainted, With all of the work we put into life, it's easy to forget that God is still maintaining His creation. All too often, we can imagine the "first article gifts" spoken of in the Small Catechism (body, soul, eyes, ears, members, reason, senses, clothing, shoes, food, drink, house, home, wife, children, land, animals, and all that you have), as being only the first step in gift-giving. But God still takes care of them. Every pump of air into a bike tired, every spray of WD-40 onto a creaky door hinge, every blade of grass clipped by the lawn mower is a gift from God. How does this mindfulness affect the way we view the world? How do we respond with thanks and praise, service, and obedience?
